It is stated (page 2/37 of the plan)"When a work order for auxiliary thermoplastic pavement markings is issued, the quantities will be given out in the following minimums."

Lane Arrow 4 each
Word on Pavement, 96" 4 each
Stop Line 100 feet
Channelizing Line 250 feet
Transverse Line 300 feet
Crosswalk Line 50 feet

I understand this to mean the Contractor may be issued a work order for an amount as small as 50 feet of Crosswalk Line or 4 Lane Arrows. Is this correct? Because of the potentially high costs associated with this kind of work (spending half a day repairing a handful of Lane Arrows), District 8 allowed a charge for each work order that was issued in their maintenance contract (225-04). Would ODOT do the same here for these work orders?

The District would prefer the "Work Order" portion of this contract to be administered as stated in the plan. Please bid the project accordingly.

On page 67 of the Proposal under 644.06 Basis of Payment, a list of descriptions is given. Would ODOT consider using the Railroad Symbol Marking description instead of treating each Railroad Symbol Marking as a Word on Pavement, 96" with 50 feet of Channelizing Line, 24" and 28 feet of Stop Line (page 25/37 of the plan)? Also would ODOT consider using the School Symbol Marking description rather than refering to each School Symbol Marking as a Word on Pavement, 96" with X number of feet of Channelizing, 16" (page 25/37 of the plan)?

The plan quantities provide for the SCHOOL and R X R markings to be installed as per design standards. Please bid the project as is.
