In regards to Project Number 060232 on the May 26th letting, line item 0057 is specified for use of 5 ea. work zone impact attenuator Quadguard CZ, QZ2403Y. We are the distributor for Trinity Industries TRACC family of crash cushions that was recently approved in Ohio for permanent and work zone sites. Trinity's SHORTRACC is an equivalent to the Quadguard CZ, QZ2403Y. Would it be possible to let contractors know that this would also be an approved unit for this job?
