Ref #'s 176 & 185, Steel drip strip, are not needed because you cannot put drip strip on bridges with a concrete safety curb & parapet.

Page 30/230 – Item – 603 Conduits: Addresses the pipe size, flow line elevations and connections according to drawing DM-1.1. It fails to elaborate on the existing pipe types. This will determine whether a mechanical or concrete collar connection will be required.

Question Number: 3

There is no typical section in the plans showing what the "Single Slope Barrier, Type D" is sitting on. The standard RM-4.5 states that the wall will either sit on new or existing concrete or asphalt pavement, but the typical shows no shoulder widening for barrier placement. Is it to be assumed that the wall will sit on the existing shoulder pavement, which in effect will decrease the total shoulder width by 1'8", or will the wall be placed beyond the edge of the existing shoulder pavement? If the wall is to be outside of the existing shoulder pavement what is it to sit on (the standard RM-4.5 does not make provisions for this)?

Per the standard RM-4.6 page 1 of 3 and 3 of 3 dated 1/16/04 the Concrete Barrier End Sections are to be paid for under their own pay item by the "each". We can not find pay items for the end sections in these plans. For the "Concrete Barrier, Single Slope, Type A" and "Concrete Barrier, Single Slope, Type D" bid items, where is the cost of the Concrete Barrier End Sections to be included?
