We have two questions related to the curb ramp work:

1) There is 3,000 sf of Curb Ramp (Item # 7) set up in this project as contingency, " for replacing existing Non-ADA Compliant Curb Ramps Throughout the Facility, as determined by the engineer wiht new curb ramps with truncated domes..." If any curb or curb&gutter has to be replaced in conjunction with installing curb ramps we are assuming it will be paid for the the linear foot using items #3 or #4 - "Curb Removed"/"Curb & Gutter Removed" and items #9 or #10 - "Comb. Curb & Gutter Type 2, APP"/"Curb Type 6". If, instead, this curb is to be incidental to the curb ramp then please let us know how much curb quantity to include in the Curb Ramp (Item # 7) for the 3,000 sf of contingency.

2) Page 21 of the plans in the "Payment" Paragraph states that truncated domes are to be included in the price of the ramps. However, on this job there is a sepearte pay item called "Walkway Misc. Truncated Domes on Curb Ramps". Is it to be assumed no cost for Truncated Domes are to be included in the curb ramp pay item? Also, is the square feet of curb ramp going to be paid through the truncated dome area (there is 4" of concrete walk underneath the truncated domes and setting bed)?

Page 3/30 Typical Sections show "Full Width Pavement Planing" and "Tapered Pavement Planing" sections. Both sections have the same parking lots shown. Which lots apply to each of the typical sections? Is the tapered planing sections paid under the same item as the full width planing section?
