1) There are hundreds of dowel holes required on the 4132 bridge and no quantity set up for them. They are not called out to be incedental to other work.2) There are very short completions (ie 56hrs, weekend closures, etc) set up on the project, but the specifications require 3 day cures on all the overlays. This requirement has not been waived. It is not possible to do this, unless we are allowed to hydro the decks during the day and let traffic run on them before overlaying... which is not normally allowed. What is ODOT going to enforce and what are they going to allow? It can't be both ways. Even if traffic is allowed between the hydro and the pouring, you can not get more than 15-20 hrs of cure on the 4318R bridge, which is restricted to a 56hr work period.
