253 pavement repairs are specified as 8" deep. In some areas there is approx 5" of asphalt on top of either a brick base or a 7" concrete base. Is the contractor expected to remove the brick base as part of the repair? Is the contractor expected to remove the full thickness of concrete base?

#### The brick is to be removed as part of the repair but not the concrete.

On plan sheets 100 and 101 it shows walks and HC ramps to be installed. There are no quantities provided for these items in the proposal. The Walk and Ramp quantities that are in the proposal refer to work at other areas of the job.
