The welding bid item is set up for 1 lft of weld per location.

Assume the crack is found be 4" long.

Assume the engineer pays for 1/3 of a lineal foot.

The contractor must pay the cost of a labratory to inspect the weld. This is a considerable cost and is not much changed if the weld length is reduced by 8". Other costs are not reduced proportionately. We expect the welds to be less than 1 lft.

Please advise if it is ODOT policy to pay 1 lft or 4".

If policy is to pay for 4", we suggest a plan note stating the minimum pay item for welding at one location is I lft.

Please advise if it is ODOT policy to pay 1 lft or 4" as assumed above.

The plans show traffic control trucks equipped with truck mounted traffic attenuators. The description of the trucks in the traffic notes does not mention attenuators. Please advise the intent of the plans.

The intent of the plan is to provide protection vehicles with truck mounted traffic attenuators as shown on page 7/13. The cost of these vehicles are included with Item 614- Maintaining Traffic as per note on page 2/13.

sheet 12 lists 22 operations as cope. sheet 13 shows 2 examples of a cope. sheet 13 shows one example of drilling a 2" diameter hole. the pay item is for 22 ea drilling. sh 2 describes drilling 2" holes at ends of cracks. please advise how a cope is to be paid for. sh 13 also shows a cope that is 1/2 of a two inch hole. please advise the intent of the plans.
