Sheet 3 of the plans references a temporary pumping system under the Sanitary Sewer note that runs between the proposed manholes during the construction of the culvert. Under which item does the Department intend to pay for the pumping system?

The bypass pumping shall be included in the cost of the 200 mm conduit, Type B, Ductile Iron Pipe, Item 603 01900.

Question Number: 4

Question 1: What are the limits of the steel casing pipe for the sanitary line shown on sheet 27 (box only or manhole to manhole)? Is this casing pipe to be galvanized per 638? Question 2: The temporary sheeting plan on drawing 21 states "the design . . . is one representative design that may be used . . ." Has the design shown, along with calculations, been submitted to the railroad for approval or will the contractor need to furnish a detailed design for submittal, or will ODOT furnish the details and calculations for submittal?

A1) The detail show the casing pipe in the box and is described as 4 M, Steel Casing...it is only in the box. A2) Per the CMS, 638, Steel Casing Pipe, the pipe is to be galvanized unless it is going to be bored or jacked. In this case it will not be bored or jacked, but will be pushed thru the box culvert and therefore will need to be galvanized. A3) Per the note on Sheet 4 of the plans, under Structure Excavation and Shoring, the third paragraph, it states that "The Contractor shall submit the following drawings and calculations for Railroad review and approval." The District has not submitted a design and will not submit a design to the railroad. There is contact information for the railroad also contained within the note.
