As long as the new traffic signal is complete when traffic is opened up on SR 95, is it necessary to maintain the existing signal during construction when only North and South traffic is permitted through the intersection?

There are notes on plan sheets 4 and 5B addressing this issue. The contractor should construct the proposed traffic signal first and then remove the existing signal and the island. The lead time for the traffic signal poles are usually 14-16 weeks. The MOT should not be in affect any longer than necessary to construct the island.
