On sheet 6/15, the "EX. GROUND @ CENTERLINE" is the centerline of SR 285. Since at station 611+70.54, 613+35.74 and 614+38.39 there is offsets and flow line elevations for the 6" underdrain, we think here is sufficient information to construct the underdrain
