The plan notes on drawings 11 and 12 require the oak timbers for Ref. No. 20, Item Special, Timber flooring to have preservative treatment. We have talked w/ three lumber suppliers, they have all stated that oak is too dense and can not be treated as required. Please advise.

The notes on sheets 11 & 12 indicates the treatment is to pressure treat to 0.6 lb/cu. ft. retention or refusal. If the material can not meet the 0.6 lb/cu. ft. retention requirement or refuses treatment entirely this is acceptable, but an effort to treat this material shall be made.
