RE: MH's No.1 & 3, CB's 3 & 3A and adjoining pipe work on pages 16 & 17.

On page 10, MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC No.1, it states a minimum of one ten foot lane in each direction shall be maintained the 3 lane section.

Due to the constructability of the manholes and the safety of our workers and the traveling public in this section, especially Manhole No. 1 at Sta. 1069+78 only one lane of traffic can be maintained during the construction of this item.

There is not sufficient room for sheeting, shoring and barrier wall to maintain 2 lane traffic.

Q: Would it be in the best interest of the motoring public for the Department to provide a detour to complete this work.

Q: Will the contractor be allowed to work around the clock to complete this work?
