Q 1- S No. Transition barrier is paid for as regular barrier per SCD RM-4.4 Q 2- 100 feet each location. Only 90' of barrier is being replaced, the 100' is showing the length of temporary barrier necessary to protect the opening.Q 3- It is very difficult to install new sign bases in the same location as existing sign bases.Q 4 The detail being referred to on page 24 (Type D Barrier) is not used in the plans. Other details on this sheet are used. The earlier question you refer to was for the Single Slope Concrete barrier, not for the "New Jersey" style.
