The new pavement section for the SB outside shoulders that is required to be built during phase 1A needs to be performed during off peak hours. Traffic maintenance notes refer to page 73 for details of the drop off treatment in workzones. However, at no time is the drop off one foot away from the traveled lane as described in column one of the drop off table on sheet 73. What is the drop off treatment when the drop off is zero feet away from the edge of pavement? Also, detail A on sheet 9 shows milling to a depth of 3" into the existing pavement one foot. What is the drop off treatment when work is in the travel lane?

We are confused on what you want in the median as shown on sheet 25. Two questions/comments:

(1) If there are just to be two double rows of pavers on each side of the median, we come up with a much smaller quantity of concrete pavers than the plans show.

(2) Is it your intention that all "imported" dirt required to raise the center of the median to the desired cross-section be topsoil?
