Plan sheet 141/159, under the 202 Removal note, states that "The contractor shall provide protection for falling debris over Duck Creek." Will saw slurry be considered "Debris" amd covered under this note?

Question Number: 3

The Power Service note on p.125 calls for the contractor to pay all power company fees associated with the installation and connection of the power service. The AEP solution center (listed in the plans)requires a work order to be placed in order to get an "estimate" on the proposed work. How can the contractor include an accurate cost in the bid without this number? A work order would only be placed after the contract for this project is awarded. Item 625.16 in the CMS says "Charges made by the power company.... will be bourne by the maintaining agency" due to the uncertain cost at the time of bid. Please issue an addendum for this item.

The plans supersede the CMS, therefore bid as per the plans. The contractor should be able to meet with the utility company and get an estimate for the work.
