In order to get the bridge deck overlay work done faster, cheaper, to provide higher quality/longer lasting overlays and to avoid bidding errors, would the District consider allowing the use of hydrodemolition surface preparation instead of jackhammer surface preparation on the bridge decks? A land application permit for disposal of the hydrodemolition runoff water is now available for use on ODOT projects.

Hydrodemolition is not permitted on this project. Bid per the plans and specifications. No addendum required.

Can portable traffic signals be used in lieu of installing poles and hard wiring as specified in the standard drawings and in the contract?

According to Construction Administration and the Central Office Traffic Department, material specs don't necessarily have to be listed on the title sheet. Since the reference to SS 961 is contained within MT-96.11 (which is a contract document since it's listed on the title sheet), the answer to Mr. Lovace's question is yes, he's allowed to use a portable traffic signal as long as it meets the conditions specified in the SCD notes.
