Requirements for Inclusion on the Qualified Product List

Material must be approved by the Office of Traffic Engineering as meeting the requirements of ODOT Supplement 1049.

Submit to the Office of Materials Management the following information:

- 1. A manufacturer's letter certifying the reflective sheeting supplied to the project will meet or exceed Departmental Specifications and include:
 - a. A 12" x 12"(300 mm x 300 mm) sample of each Type and Class for marking identification. Include order information per ASTM D 4956 Section 5.
 - b. Marking identification method so field personnel can identify product with manufacturer. This can include electronic picture format. Provide multiple samples/pictures if typical markings are different.
- 2. Agreement to immediately notify the Office of Materials Management of any changes in production and/or materials before shipment.
- 3. A contact name, number and e-mail address.
- 4. Re-certification documentation by January 1st of each year. Re-certification will be based on Office of Materials Management approval.

Acceptance by the Department

The Office of Materials Management will review a manufacturer's submittal for compliance with specification requirements.

Accepted products will be listed on the Department's Qualified Product List (QPL) web page and will be loaded into the Department's Construction Management System for acceptance in the field through the QPL screen.

Field Documentation Requirements

Products on the QPL will be accepted if they can be identified in the field to a supplier/manufacturer listed on the Department's Qualified Products List.
