*This project involves the replacement of the High Street bridge in the City of Jackson, Jackson County, Ohio. This existing structure is a 93 FT, pony truss bridge with a corrugated steel deck and asphalt overlay that is supported on concrete substructure units. The proposed structure is a 100 FT single span galvanized truss with a concrete deck supported on concrete abutments on drilled shaft foundations.*
