## Issue 6: State and US Bicycle Route Systems



### What is a Bicycle Route?

A bicycle route involves multiple types of bicycling infrastructure, such as off-road paths, bicycle lanes and low-traffic roads. While not a construction project, Ohio's bike route system will join together facilities that communities around the state have been developing for years.

### What is Ohio Doing?

Signs are being installed to designate Ohio's first official US Bike Route, USBR 50. Other routes are being reviewed for similar designation.

Once complete, Ohio's nearly 3,500 mile network of State and US Bicycle Routes will connect Ohio communities to each other and to our neighboring states. These routes will be fully designated early in 2017.
